

対人関係への衡平理論の適用：予備的検討

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An Application of Equity Theory to Interpersonal Relations: A Preliminary Study

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This study was designed to test the applicability of equity theory to interpersonal relations. Eighty-two female undergraduates were asked to assess equity/inequity and emotional qualities of the relationships with their best same-sex and opposite-sex friends. They also assessed various aspects of their exchanges as inputs or outcomes.

The results were as follows :

- 1) Consistent with equity theory, perceptions of equity/inequity were related to emotional qualities.
- 2) Results of multiple regression analyses indicated that assessments of each other's input and outcome as a whole were determined by different aspects of their exchanges.
