The river in medieval Czech chronicles

In the middle ages that transportation infrastructure had not yet developed, water route was more important than land route. This paper examined that recognition of the river in Czech medieval people.

The results of analysis of Czech medieval chronicles, such as *Kosmova kronika česká*, *Pokračovatelé kosmovi*, *Dalimilova kronika*, confirmed that medieval Czech chroniclers had no interest in the river as a mean of transport. They mentioned river in geographical depiction, but not in commercial, traffical one. Of course, in medieval Czech, for example, trades of salts carried by rivers were active. But charters rarely told concrete information.
