A study on the control of the Comedown Village (the *Reirakumura* 零落村):  
the example of Kumamoto fief in the 19th century

IMAMURA Naoki

The aim of this paper is to illuminate the role which the regional administrative organ (the *tenaga* 手永) played on the occasion of the revival enterprise of “the comedown village (the *Reirakumura* 零落村)” in the 19th century Kumamoto fief. As a result, having become clear is as follows. The regional administrative organ actively performed arrangement of the debt of “the comedown village” and supply of the reconstruction fund. That is, the regional administrative organ had played an essential role for the revival enterprise. Furthermore, the regional administrative organ tried to manage each farmer’s work in “the comedown village”. In the local society in the 19th century, the administrative power which carries out the control of the farmers’ action began to be born.
